Thank you for taking part in our project.

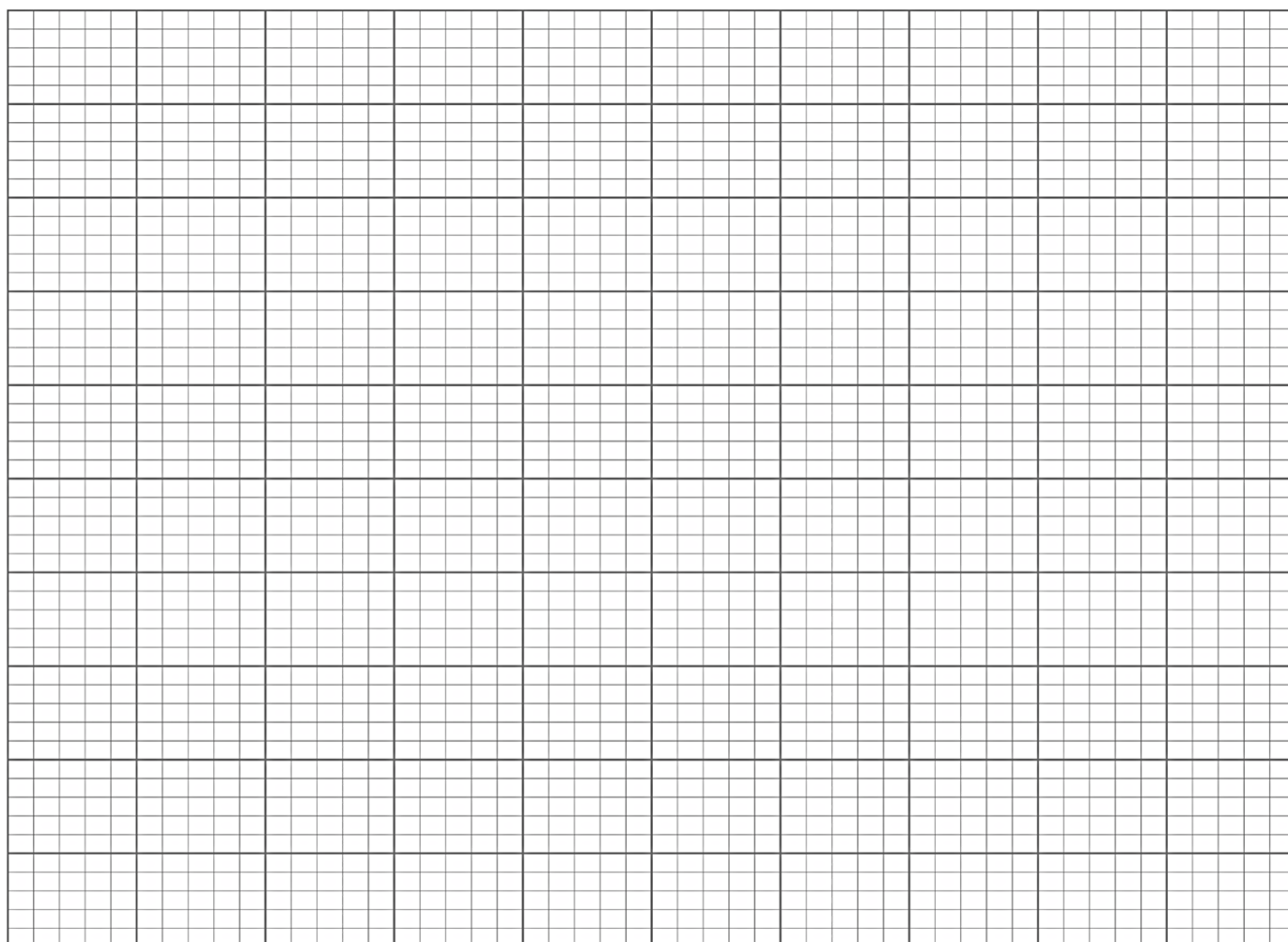
Below is some graph paper so that you can mark up your pattern/design and a form so that you can tell us the story behind your design.

(If you are inspired by Ganseys and wish your work to be in that style – here’s some advice-)

To produce a 10 x 10cm square, using the suggested yarn, you will need to cast on 40 stitches and knit 50 rows. The graph paper is stitch-related (more rows than stitches) you can use it to design/work out your pattern before knitting.

We suggest you make a border of 2 rows of purl stitch at the top, bottom and sides of the square. This will help the sample sit flat and help with future display.

(We understand that if you are using yarns from your area, you may not be working with Guernsey 5 ply or 2.5mm gauge needles.)
